

CITS Admissions-Session 2026-27 - FAQs

Q: How to participate in the counseling?

A: Counselling is a complete online process, where the candidate need to login the admission portal to participate in the counselling.

Q: Do I need to select all given choices of institute?

A: Yes, it is compulsory to select all the given choices and arrange them according to your preference. Once the seat allotment is completed, your choices will be frozen and cannot be changed.

Q: After seat allotment can I cancel the allotted seat?

A: Yes, after seat allotment, your seat can be cancelled by sending a request email to NIMI and submitting the required cancellation undertaking.

Q: If I skip the document verification, am I eligible for second counselling round.

A: Yes, if you don't take provisional admission, you are eligible for the subsequent round.

Q: If I have been allotted seat as per my first choice, am I eligible for transfer round?

OR

Q: If I have been allotted seat and documents verified as per my first choice, am I eligible for further counselling process like round 2 & 3 counselling, SPOT round etc.

A: No, as you have been allotted seat as per your first choice, you are not eligible for transfer round and subsequent counselling rounds.

Q: If I have been allotted seat in the transfer round, and I am not willing to join the institute, am I eligible for 2nd transfer round.

A: No, you are not eligible for the subsequent transfer round. Only one transfer is allowed.

Q: If I have not allotted seat in the transfer round, am I eligible for subsequent transfer round.

A: Yes, you are eligible for the subsequent transfer round.

Q: What about the counselling fee?

A: Counselling fee is Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) to be paid one time and not refundable. It should be paid online through the given payment gateway option only.

Q: What are all the documents required to be carried during document verification?

A: Please take all the documents which you uploaded in your application during registration, in addition, you must carry your Adhaar card, Qualification, Community, Priority certificates as applicable in original . Any document found inappropriate will result in termination of candidature.

Community Certificate should be as per Central Government category.

Q: Do medical certificate need to be taken during document verification?

A: For PH candidate it is must, but other candidates, if institute insists please produce it.

Q: Who can participate in SPOT round?

A: Candidates who have not allotted seat in any of the counseling rounds are eligible to participate in SPOT round.

Q: During SPOT round how to pay the counseling fee?

A: **The fee can be paid through the Candidates' dashboard online mode only once seat confirmed.**

Q: What is the course fee structure at NSTI & IToT?

A: The fee structure for the NSTI is given in the prospectus & The fees structure of State Government and Private IToT Institutes is determined by the respective bodies. Please refer the prospectus and can be clarified at the Institutes.

Q: How can I get hostel accommodation?

A: Hostel facilities are maintained by the concerned institute. Therefore, for any hostel requirement please contact the respective institute directly.

Q: When do I need to report the institute for physical admission?

A: The candidates must report to the allotted institute for physical admission between 10th August 2026 (Monday) and 14th August 2026 (Friday). Refer to the NIMI portal regularly for updates.

Q: When the session will commence?

A: The academic session will commence on 17th August 2026. Refer the admission schedule and NIMI portal regularly for updates.

Q: Where to pay the tuition fee and other fees? Do I need to pay online?

A: The payment process will be explained by the allotted institute during physical admission. Candidates are advised to follow the instructions provided by the institute.
